Programme Components

Academic Enrichment (1.5 hrs):

We aim to mould our pupils into confident, independent learners. Our classes revisit topics taught during school to give our pupils a chance to practise their understanding of the subject.

Sports (1.5 hrs):

Physical activity helps children concentrate better in class. Through fundamental movement modules and modified games, we aim to develop the physical skills of our pupils and instil in them the importance of sportsmanlike behaviour.

- Includes: Fundamental Movement, Modified Ball Games, Modular Sports

Terms and Conditions

Conditions for subsidised programme fees

- To qualify for the programme, parents or guardians must <u>already</u> be registered under the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS), and provide the relevant documents as proof.
- Students must attend at **least 80% of the programme.** The student may be withdrawn from the programme at our discretion should the student's attendance fall below the 80% mark without a valid reason.

- If the students sign up for, but fail to attend more than 2 of the above events without valid reason, the student may be suspended from the programme.

Conditions for withdrawal after commencement of programme

A minimum of one month's notice (provided to us at the telephone number or email address stated above)
is required from the parent or guardian (as may be applicable) for withdrawal of the student from the
